Please find details for the continuance of the first and third BSc semesters below.

### **Semester 1 BSc: Food & Beverage**

- Written final exams will be from Wednesday 4 November 2020
- Exams will be held in the auditorium (Aula)
- You can take your breaks between exams in the **Club SHL**
- Students will continue to be provided with meals
- Start of culinary courses: Monday, 09 November 2020 via MS Teams at **09:15**
- Lessons via MS teams: 09 November 2020 to 20 November 2020 (2 weeks)
- Practical culinary module on site at SHL: from 23 November 2020 (4 weeks)
- Lessons via MS teams: from 10 January 2021 until the end of the semester on 05.02.2021 (4 weeks)
- The written mid-term and final examinations are scheduled to take place on site at SHL.
- A programme for the Christmas holidays will be ensured

### **Semester 3 BSc: Rooms Division**

- From Monday, 2 November 2020, lessons will be in distance learning via MS Teams
- Written exams are planned to take place on site at SHL as scheduled
- Exams will be held in the auditorium (Aula)

- Students will continue to be provided with meals
- A programme for the Christmas holidays will be ensured
