(1) Swiss students (incl. Principality of Liechtenstein) and students with a B residence permit (not including residence permit B for educational purposes) or C residence permit are generally eligible to receive subsidised school fees by their canton of residence or place of origin. SHL and HSLU submit an application on behalf of the students to the canton liable for granting the subsidies. Students from abroad who are resident in Switzerland before commencing their studies can also submit an application for clarification.

(2) Includes all digital learning materials, exam fees, excursions, study & field trips, a knife set, as well as kitchen and service uniforms. The application fee of CHF 280 (non-refundable) is to be paid upon submission of an online application and is therefore not included in the Tuition Fees.

(3) SHL Service Fees include the admissions process, programme coordination, study trip organisation as well as the coordination with HSLU.

(4) HSLU Tuition and Service Fees - invoiced directly by HSLU. HSLU Service Fees include course materials, examination fees, and study or field trips. Full details are outlined in the HSLU budget plan which can be found on the HSLU website.

(5) Breakfast, lunch and dinner from Monday to Thursday, breakfast and lunch on Friday on SHL campus. In semesters 6.2, 7 and 8, the allowance is reduced, as returning to the SHL campus for lunch every day is not always possible or practical.

(6) Additional fees are optional and available on request. The campus and F&B fees in semesters 6.2, 7 and 8 are linked and cannot be booked separately.

Semesters 2 and 4 are paid 6-month industry internships.

- Students must complete at least one of the internships in Switzerland.
- The minimum gross salary per month for internships in Switzerland is CHF 2'390.
